Step 1: The existing glare shield area was stripped and refinished with non-glare matte urethane.



Step 2: The radio access plate was reinstalled.



Step 3: Randy trial fits to see where glare shield needs to be trimmed. You can install the glare shield with or without the windshield installed.



Step 4: Randy accomplishes gross trimming with shears to remove excess material.



Bill final trims on belt sander to get to trim line and produce a smooth finish.
